



COVID-19 ADJUSTMENTS

We are so thrilled that you are joining NC Music Center for music lessons!! We want to assure you of how safe we are making sure our facility will be so that you can be safe, upon your arrival. Our facility has been upgraded with hand sanitizer dispensers outside of lesson rooms, dividers are set up for voice, guitar, and violin students. All Instructors and staff will have their temperatures taken upon arrival. In addition, all staff will be required to wear face masks during their time in the facility. Our studio will be disinfecting & sanitizing common areas and lesson rooms all throughout the day.

OUR SAFETY PROTOCOL

All of our instructors will have their temperatures checked upon arrival and also will wash their hands with antibacterial soap. If they are sick, they will be required to leave and go home. Instructors will practice social distancing in their lessons. Immediately following each lesson teachers will sanitize the lesson room by wiping down piano keys, piano bench, pencils, and any additional items touched before starting their next lesson. **All Instructors and Staff will wear masks during their lessons and the entire time in the facility.**

STUDENTS

Students will be asked to remain in their cars, or right outside the front door until their actual lesson time. At their lesson time they will be let in by their instructor. Underaged Students (18 and under) must be supervised by a parent or guardian before entering the studio. Upon entering students must sanitize their hands and head directly to their lesson. Students should also wear a mask during their lesson, we have extras at the front desk if you need one!

WAITING AREA

Our waiting/lobby will remain closed at this time. Parents can always accompany their child to lessons, however younger siblings and/or additional guests will not be permitted to enter.

VIRTUAL LESSONS

We will offer virtual lessons ongoing and continuously for students who would prefer to continue virtually. We offer virtual lessons via Skype or Zoom, students should be set up with a laptop or phone facing piano and student.
